## **Treasurers Report**

January, 2013.

We Started the year with a bank balance of \$7.631.02 and ended in December with a balance of \$6166.88 resulting in a reduction of Cash on hand of \$1,464.14

A recap by category Follows:

The reduction in cash is due mainly to lower than budgeted dues and membership applications, the impact of which is somewhat offset by lower than expected field maintenance at Hardyston and lower than budgeted attendance at the Christmas party.

Overall, the 2012 Budget called for a \$2,195.00 reduction in cash, of which \$1,000 was due to a \$20 credit to members who volunteered to work at club activities in 2011.
