August, 2013

The July opening balance is \$11,630.66. Collections for the month totaled \$330.11 and are represented by Applications \$100, Dues \$70 Fifty/Fifty \$22, Fuel \$45 and a return of Field Maintenance advance in Hardyston \$93.

Expenses for the month totaled \$1,031.90 represented by Mowing \$510, Porta Jon Rentals \$152 and balance of Warbird Expenses \$370.

The result is an ending cash balance of \$11,928.50 per below:
