## Treasurer's Report – January, 2016

2015 was a breakeven year for the Top O' New Jersey RC Club. We began the year with a bank balance of \$8,043.00. Our ending balance for 2015 is \$7,727.00 representing a reduction in cash of \$316.00. A reduction in Warbird reserves of \$404 was partially offset by fuel revenue of \$165 for the year.

Membership was relatively constant year over year with 112 paying members compared to 113 last year. Lower than budgeted spending on the Christmas Party of \$690.00, Squatrito Field Maintenance of \$400, and meeting room rental of \$510.00 resulted in the breakeven cash flow for the year.
